RESPONSIVE READING:

Acts 16 various verses

Leader: After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth;

People: And found a certain Jew named Aquila, born in Pontus, lately come from Italy, with his wife Priscilla; (because that Claudius had commanded all Jews to depart from Rome:) and came unto them.

Leader: And because he was of the same craft, he abode with them, and wrought: for by their occupation they were tentmakers.

People: And he reasoned in the synagogue every sabbath, and persuaded the Jews and the Greeks.

Leader: And Paul *after this* tarried *there* yet a good while, and then took his leave of the brethren, and sailed thence into Syria, and with him Priscilla and Aquila; having shorn *his* head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow.

People: And he came to Ephesus, and left them there: but he himself entered into the synagogue, and reasoned with the Jews.

Leader: When they desired *him* to tarry longer time with them, he consented not;

People: But bade them farewell, saying, I must by all means keep this feast that cometh in Jerusalem: but I will return again unto you, if God will. And he sailed from Ephesus.

Leader: And a certain Jew named Apollos, born at Alexandria, an eloquent man, *and* mighty in the scriptures, came to Ephesus.

People: This man was instructed in the way of the Lord; and being fervent in the spirit, he spake and taught diligently the things of the Lord, knowing only the baptism of John.
