History of the Board of Deacons of TRUE LOVE Missionary Baptist Church

The Deacon Board was organized in 1943 under the leadership of the late Pastor, Rev. Ernest N. Cox. The first Chairman was Deacon William R. Davis, and he served from 1943 to 1951 under the leadership of Rev. Ernest N. Cox.

The Board's second Chairman was Deacon Jerry M. Cochran. He served faithfully from 1951 to 2000, under the leadership of the late Pastors, Rev. Ernest N. Cox and Rev. Herbert B. Robinson, Sr.

The Board's third Chairman was Deacon Howard Denson. He served under the leadership of the late Rev. Herbert B. Robinson, Sr. from 2000 to 2002. After the death of Pastor Robinson in 2002, Deacon Denson continued to serve as the Board Chairman. He worked diligently with the Joint Board of Deacons and Trustees in seeking a Pastor for the church, until his death in 2004.

The Board's fourth Chairman was Deacon Jimmy Staples, and he served from 2005-2006 under Rev. Richard Fields.

The Board's fifth Chairman was Deacon Thomas R. Latimer, and he served from 2006 to 2023.

The Board's sixth Chairman was Deacon Thomas E. Anderson. Has was elected in 2024 and served faithfully under our Pastor, Dr. Herbert B. Robinson, Jr. until his death later the same year.

The Board's seventh Chairman is Deacon Tod V. Miller. He was elected in 2025 and serves faithfully under the leadership of our Pastor, Dr. Herbert B. Robinson, Jr.

HISTORY OF THE DEACONESSSES OF TRUE LOVE MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH

The Deaconesses were organized under the leadership of the late Pastor Ernest N. Cox in 1967. He recognized the need for Christian women to be involve in the furtherance of church programming. Pastor Cox assigned Deacon Richard Ryan to the Deaconesses Ministry as a liaison official. The late Deacons Jerry Cochran, Ozzie Gardner and Howard Denson all served this ministry. Deacon Thomas Dixon currently serves as the Deaconesses liaison Deacon.

The Deaconesses prepare the Lord's Supper and Communion table monthly for 1st Sunday worship service and whenever requested by the Pastor, as well as prepare candidates for baptism. A Deaconesses will sometimes accompany a Deacon to serve communion to sick and shut-in members in their homes, hospital, or nursing home. This Outreach is a blessing for all who are involved.
