History of the Board of Deacons of TRUE LOVE M. B. Church

The Deacon Board was organized in 1943 under the leadership of the late Rev. Ernest N. Cox. The Board's first Chairman was Deacon William R. Davis. He served from 1943-1951 under the leadership of Reverend Ernest N. Cox.

The Board's second Chairman was Deacon Jerry M. Cochran. He served faithfully from 1951—2000 under the leadership of both the late Rev. Ernest N. Cox, and the late Rev. Herbert B. Robinson, Sr.

Deacon Howard Denson served as the third Chairman from 2000 until his death in 2004. After the death of Pastor Robinson, Sr. in 2002, Deacon Denson worked diligently with the Joint Boards of Deacons and Trustees in seeking a pastor for the church.

The Board's fourth Chairman was Deacon Jimmy Staples. He served from 2005—2006 under Rev. Richard B. Fields.

The Board's fifth Chairman was Deacon Thomas R. Latimer. He served from 2006—2023.

The Board's sixth Chair is Thomas Anderson who was appointed in 2024.

History of the Deacon Wives & Deaconesses of True Love Missionary Baptist Church

The Deaconesses were organized under the leadership of the late Pastor Ernest N. Cox in 1967. He recognized the need for Christian women in the furtherance of the church program. Pastor Cox assigned Deacon Richard Ryan to the Deaconess Ministry as Liaison Official.

Sister Anderson provided the Deaconess Ministry with faithful and conscientious service. Under her leadership, the Deaconesses grew spiritually and numerically. Under Sister Darveta Woodford's leadership, the same faithful and conscientious service to this office has continued.

The Deaconesses, along with the Deacons, serve Communion each first Saturday and Sunday to the sick and shut-in at their homes, hospitals, and nursing homes. This out-reach is a blessed experience. In addition, the Lord's Supper is prepared for worship service on the first Sunday of each month and whenever requested by the Pastor.

The late Deacon Jerry Cochran, and the late Deacon Ozzie Gardner greatly blessed this ministry. The Deaconesses were favored to have the late Deacon Howard Denson as their Auxiliary Deacon. Currently, Deacon Thomas Dixon is the Auxiliary Deacon.
