## God the Omnipotent

*Leader:* (To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David.) O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known *me*.

**Congregation:** **Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off.**

*Leader:* Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted *with* all my ways.

**Congregation:** **For *there is* not a word in my tongue, *but*, lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether.**

*Leader:* Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me.

Congregation: *Such* knowledge *is* too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot *attain* unto it.
