Luke 6:1-10

- Leader:** And it came to pass on the second sabbath after the first, that he went through the corn fields; and his disciples plucked the ears of corn, and did eat, rubbing *them* in *their* hands.
- People:** And certain of the Pharisees said unto them, Why do ye that which is not lawful to do on the sabbath days?
- Leader:** And Jesus answering them said, *Have ye not read so much as this, what David did, when himself was an hungred, and they which were with him;*
- People:** *How he went into the house of God, and did take and eat the shewbread, and gave also to them that were with him; which it is not lawful to eat but for the priests alone?*
- Leader:** And he said unto them, *That the Son of man is Lord also of the sabbath.*
- People:** And it came to pass also on another sabbath, that he entered into the synagogue and taught: and there was a man whose right hand was withered.
- Leader:** And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal on the sabbath day; that they might find an accusation against him.
- People:** But he knew their thoughts, and said to the man which had the withered hand, *Rise up, and stand forth in the midst.* And he arose and stood forth.
- Leader:** Then said Jesus unto them, *I will ask you one thing; Is it lawful on the sabbath days to do good, or to do evil? to save life, or to destroy it?*
- ... All:** And looking round about upon them all, he said unto the man, *Stretch forth thy hand.* And he did so: and his hand was restored whole as the other.
