1 Corinthians 9:24–10:6

Leader: Know ye not that they which run in a race run all, but one receiveth the prize? So run, that ye may obtain.

People: And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they *do it* to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.

Scholarship History

Over 50 years ago, in 1972, the children's choir, which consisted of 93 children ages 2 to 14, performed a very successful concert at the Adlai Stevenson Building. The funds were appropriated by the newly elected, the late Pastor Herbert B. Robinson, Sr. to start a ***"Children's Scholarship Fund"***.

The original Board of Directors were: Sister Ozella Houston (president), Sister Queen Ester Hill (secretary/treasurer), Brother Thomas Dixon (committee member) and Pastor H. B. Robinson, Sr., as overseer.

A year later, Ms. Melba Bates contributed \$500 to the scholarship fund and requested that a Memorial fund would be set-up in her daughter's name. The Arielle H. Bates Memorial Fund was added to the overall scholarship fund. Arielle Bates departed this life on March 22, 1972. Ms. Melba Bates, in whose memory we cherish, was active in several organizations and made many outstanding contributions to this church.

In 1988, the first scholarships were given to three individuals for \$250.00 each. Since 1988, with your contributions on the church envelopes, you have helped through scholarships and grants, over 85 True Love students in pursuing higher education. In recent years we have been fortunate to be able to award up to \$4,000.00 for scholarships and \$1,500.00 for grants to students who meet the church's standards and qualifications.

We would like to encourage all of our True Love students who are graduating next year to obtain 3.0 GPA from high school. Current college students and grant recipients must have no less than a 2.5 GPA. We would like to continue helping students maintain excellence in their studies.
