RESPONSIVE READING:

Galatians 2:15–3:3

- Leader:** We *who are* Jews by nature, and not sinners of the Gentiles,
- People:** Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.
- Leader:** But if, while we seek to be justified by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, *is* therefore Christ the minister of sin? God forbid.
- People:** For if I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a transgressor.
- Leader:** For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God.
- People:** I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Leader:** I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness *come* by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.
- People:** O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you?
- Leader:** This only would I learn of you, Received ye the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?
- .. All:** Are ye so foolish? having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made perfect by the flesh?

The boiling point. When the temperature of a liquid turns into gas at a given pressure is the boiling point. How much pressure must a Christian be under before reaching a boiling point?

I raise that question because it is interesting to think how often did Jesus come close to a boiling point with all of the evil doers He had encountered? As Christians, we are encouraged to be like Jesus, but we reach our boiling points much quicker than Him. We live under pressure much more than we need to because we don't put all of our concerns in the hands of Christ.
