# RESPONSIVE READING:

## *Acts 4:32–5:4*

**Leader:** And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any *of them* that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

**People:** And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

**Leader:** Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,

**People:** And laid *them* down at the apostles' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need.

**Leader:** And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, (which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,) a Levite, *and* of the country of Cyprus,

**People:** Having land, sold *it*, and brought the money, and laid *it* at the apostles' feet.

**Leader:** But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession,

**People:** And kept back *part* of the price, his wife also being privy to *it*, and brought a certain part, and laid *it* at the apostles' feet.

**Leader:** But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back *part* of the price of the land?

**...All:** Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God.
