Reverend Dr. Jerome L. Warfield, Sr.

Rev. Warfield's spiritual journey began at the age of eight when he accepted Christ at Calvary Baptist Church. For over three decades, he served faithfully as a lay member prior to being elevated as an Associate Minister at Unity Missionary Baptist Church under the mentorship of the late Rev. Dr. Valmon D. Stotts. In March 2020, he was called to lead the congregation as its Pastor.

Stepping into this role at the onset of a global pandemic, Pastor Warfield demonstrated visionary leadership by immediately launching

a dynamic online ministry. This initiative ensured that the Unity Baptist Church family remained connected through virtual Sunday school, Bible study, and worship services, leading to remarkable spiritual and financial growth and a consistent influx of new members. Since then, he has spearheaded a comprehensive revitalization of the church, rebuilding the music and deacon's ministries, relaunching teaching programs, overseeing significant building improvements, and investing in technology to enhance the worship experience for all.

Previously, Pastor Warfield served with distinction for nearly 15 years as the sixth Pastor of Mt. Vernon Missionary Baptist Church. There, he built upon a rich legacy of community engagement, establishing the church as a beacon of hope in the Brightmoor neighborhood through vibrant outreach and powerful worship services.

Pastor Warfield's commitment to social uplift is woven into the fabric of his ministry. As president of the Brightmoor Alliance, he transformed the organization by securing funding to hire a full-time staff. His twelve-year tenure as Chairman of Trinity Community Development Corporation was marked by extraordinary success; he led a program that recruited, trained, and placed over 1,400 young people in summer employment, distributing more than \$1 million in wages and empowering the next generation.

His civic leadership extends to the highest levels of city and state government. Appointed by former Detroit Mayor Dave Bing, he served two terms as Chair of the Detroit Board of Police Commissioners. In this critical role, he led pivotal reforms, including reconstituting the Office of the Chief Investigator to ensure civilian oversight, overhauling the police towing system, and guiding the selection process for a new Chief of Police. Governor Rick Snyder appointed him to three terms on the Michigan Parole Board, where his expertise was recognized nationally, leading to his selection as a trainer for new parole board members by the National Institute of Corrections.

Today, he continues his work in public accountability as the Chief Investigator for the Detroit Board of Police Commissioners, where he leads a team dedicated to upholding the rights and safety of Detroit's citizens.

Pastor Warfield has been married to his wife, Jacqueline, for 33 years. He is the proud father of Jessica, Jerome Jr., and Justin, and the loving grandfather of Alayah Warfield. His life and work stand as a powerful example of faith in action, inspiring all who have the privilege of knowing him.
