RESPONSIVE READING:

John 4:5-14

Leader: Then cometh he to a city of Samaria, which is called Sychar, near to the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph.

People: Now Jacob's well was there. Jesus therefore, being wearied with *his* journey, sat thus on the well: *and* it was about the sixth hour.

Leader: There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, *Give me to drink.*

People: (For his disciples were gone away unto the city to buy meat.)

Leader: Then saith the woman of Samaria unto him, How is it that thou, being a Jew, askest drink of me, which am a woman of Samaria? for the Jews have no dealings with the Samaritans.

People: Jesus answered and said unto her, *If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldest have asked of him, and he would have given thee living water.*

Leader: The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water?

People: Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle?

Leader: Jesus answered and said unto her, *Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again:*

. . . All: *But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.*
