# RESPONSIVE READING:

## *Exodus 40:1-10*

- Leader:** And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- People:** On the first day of the first month shalt thou set up the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation.
- Leader:** And thou shalt put therein the ark of the testimony, and cover the ark with the vail.
- People:** And thou shalt bring in the table, and set in order the things that are to be set in order upon it; and thou shalt bring in the candlestick, and light the lamps thereof.
- Leader:** And thou shalt set the altar of gold for the incense before the ark of the testimony, and put the hanging of the door to the tabernacle.
- People:** And thou shalt set the altar of the burnt offering before the door of the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation.
- Leader:** And thou shalt set the laver between the tent of the congregation and the altar, and shalt put water therein.
- People:** And thou shalt set up the court round about, and hang up the hanging at the court gate.
- Leader:** And thou shalt take the anointing oil, and anoint the tabernacle, and all that *is* therein, and shalt hallow it, and all the vessels thereof: and it shall be holy.
- People:** And thou shalt anoint the altar of the burnt offering, and all his vessels, and sanctify the altar: and it shall be an altar most holy.
