A message from our Pastor

Praise the LORD, Saints!

“And David danced before the Lord with all his might;”

2 Samuel 6:14(KJV)

David personally selected thirty thousand (30,000) men to go with him to retrieve the ark of God from Baale of Judah. The men had to believe in David in order to follow him, but a true leader can often tell where his support comes from. Depending on the event for which they are chosen will determine who will stay and who will go.

The Bible says that when it comes to doing the Lord’s work, many are called but few are chosen. It takes a special commitment and dedicated loyalty to plunge into the unknown of God’s work. There is no promise to return unscathed, but the promise is in God not forsaking you in the heat of the battle.

The work of the Lord leaves battle scars. Fiery darts and arrows by night speedily pierce the air in search of targeted spirits. The accuracy of the enemy’s weapons should not be underestimated because you never know in whose crosshairs you may be found. It is important that you put on the whole armor of God. Protect your spirit and your flesh. If either one is compromised, it then becomes an immense mental strain.

In the midst of war, the enemy tries to take away your courage. They try to impose their will to make you forget your training. If they can strike fear into you, they will dominate and destroy. They will only take what they can get value out of. The enemy loots the arts, sciences, precious stones and metals, while raping the women, killing the men and orphaning the children. All of which tortures your mind.

The beauty of war is that there are thirty-three (33) strategies to it, that we know of. Each one can be used against the other, which suggests that one strategy is not greater than any other. It simply means, who is going to be dedicated to the end? Since the enemy will not be in power forever, exercise patience as a virtue.

Pastor's message continued

Never feel defeated in a war because the battle is not over until God says so. It's God's battle anyway.

God is the Victor. He does not lose. He will not suffer His Saints to lose or be lost. Some may fall by the wayside in the war, but the Holy Scriptures says, precious in the eyes of the Lord is the death of his Saints. It also says, to live is Christ and to die is gain. Death is a natural part of war, but never dying is the spiritual part of the battle. Jesus said, he that believes in me although he were dead, yet shall he live. And whosoever lives and believes in Christ shall never die.

The Lord expects men to fight for Him. He expects men to retrieve what the enemy has stolen. Men are protectors of women and children. Men are also protectors of God's Word. Over the years, much has been taken from us. We are ordained to get it back.

What has been taken? Our hunger and thirst for God. David chose 30,000 mighty men. Men who he could lead into battle. Men who feared God but feared no man. Men who were valiant and willing. Men who would submit to God and God alone. When you eat of God's Word daily and quench your thirst from the Living Water, you will get back everything taken from you.

David and those men successfully retrieved the ark of God as planned. The Bible says that David danced with all his might before the Lord. The men danced before the Lord with David. How do I know they danced with David? The men were David's might, who were chosen, sent and ordained by God. Men are mighty. God is Almighty. One other note. Nobody should have to dance alone, especially when it is holy dancing.

Sick & Shut-in Ministry







CITY OF DETROIT COVID-19 VACCINES UPDATE - DETROITERS

Updated: March 2nd, 2021



WHO IS ELIGIBLE AT TCF CENTER?

There is **NO COST** for the vaccine.

- **NEW!** Manufacturing employees, provided they live or work in Detroit. Employees should check with their employer first to determine whether their company vaccinations will be done at TCF or on site. Employees at FCA/Stellantis plants (Jefferson North and Mack) will be offered vaccinations on site.
- **NEW:** A Good Neighbor who is age 55 or older who lives in Detroit or in Michigan, who drives a Detroit age 60+ to the TCF Center vaccine site. The appointments must be made at the same time.
- Any resident of the City of Detroit who is age 60 or older (that means anyone born in 1960 or earlier).
- Childcare providers and K-12 school employees.
- Adult Foster Care caregivers.
- U.S. Post Office employees who live or work in Detroit.
- Employees of the City of Detroit or city-related agencies who are working from their regular job site. Employees working from home are not eligible at this time.
- Federal, state law enforcement officials who live or work in Detroit and report to a job site, such as FBI, ATF, DEA, U.S. Marshall, U.S. Attorney, State Police, and Michigan Attorney General.
- Funeral home/mortuary services employees who live or work in Detroit.
- Active members of the clergy who live or work in Detroit and whose ministry brings them into face-to-face contact with congregation members.
- All food or beverage workers living or working in the City of Detroit: Grocery stores, restaurants, meat packing, food & beverage handling facilities.
- Security guards and janitors.
- All identified populations in Group 1A. Paid and unpaid persons in health care settings who have the potential for direct or indirect exposure to patients or infectious materials working in Detroit.
- Detroit residents 18+ with intellectual and developmental disabilities, caregivers of those residents and home healthcare providers if they travel in the same vehicle during the appointment. One live-in caregiver per resident. Evidence of condition required at appointment.

HOW TO MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH THE CITY OF DETROIT COVID-19 VACCINE PROGRAM AT TCF

Appointments are being scheduled for the TCF Center. Here's how:

1. Call (313) 230-0505 Monday through Friday, 9 am – 6 pm
2. Choose Prompt 1 to make an appointment "vaccine option."
3. If you are in one of the identified groups to receive a vaccine, one caller can book for multiple people in your car. You will need 6 pieces of information for each person when you make the call:
 - Name, Address, Date of Birth, Phone number, Email, Have you had previous allergic reactions

to vaccines.

- For workers and others, you will need to provide essential work type, employer name, work address, and bring proof of employment to the vaccine appointment (i.e. work badge or employer paystub printed or on your phone).
4. You will be given appointments for 2 vaccine dates.
 5. Reminders and instructions will be sent via text and/or email.

FEMA COVID-19

Funeral Assistance

Under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 and the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, FEMA will provide financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020.

FEMA will begin to implement COVID-19 funeral assistance in April. In the meantime, people who have COVID-19 funeral expenses are encouraged to keep and gather documentation.

Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for funeral assistance, you must meet these conditions:

- The death must have occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- The death certificate must indicate the death was attributed to COVID-19.
- The applicant must be a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien who incurred funeral expenses after January 20, 2020.
- There is no requirement for the deceased person to have been a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien.

How to Apply

In April, FEMA will begin accepting applications. If you had COVID-19 funeral expenses, we encourage you to keep and gather documentation. Types of information should include:

- An official death certificate that attributes the death directly or indirectly to COVID-19 and shows that the death occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- Funeral expenses documents (receipts, funeral home contract, etc.) that includes the applicant's name, the deceased person's name, the amount of funeral expenses, and the dates the funeral expenses happened.
- Proof of funds received from other sources specifically for use toward funeral costs. We are not able to duplicate benefits received from burial or funeral insurance, financial assistance received from voluntary agencies, government agencies, or other sources.

How are Funds Received

If you are eligible for funeral assistance you will receive a check by mail, or funds by direct deposit, depending on which option you choose when you apply for assistance.
