# RESPONSIVE READING:

## Judges 6:25-32

- Leader:** And it came to pass the same night, that the LORD said unto him, Take thy father's young bullock, even the second bullock of seven years old, and throw down the altar of Baal that thy father hath, and cut down the grove that *is* by it:
- People:** And build an altar unto the LORD thy God upon the top of this rock, in the ordered place, and take the second bullock, and offer a burnt sacrifice with the wood of the grove which thou shalt cut down.
- Leader:** Then Gideon took ten men of his servants, and did as the LORD had said unto him: and so it was, because he feared his father's household, and the men of the city, that he could not do *it* by day, that he did *it* by night.
- People:** And when the men of the city arose early in the morning, behold, the altar of Baal was cast down, and the grove was cut down that *was* by it, and the second bullock was offered upon the altar *that was* built.
- Leader:** And they said one to another, Who hath done this thing? And when they enquired and asked, they said, Gideon the son of Joash hath done this thing.
- People:** Then the men of the city said unto Joash, Bring out thy son, that he may die: because he hath cast down the altar of Baal, and because he hath cut down the grove that *was* by it.
- Leader:** And Joash said unto all that stood against him, Will ye plead for Baal? will ye save him? he that will plead for him, let him be put to death whilst *it is yet* morning: if he *be* a god, let him plead for himself, because *one* hath cast down his altar.
- ... All:** Therefore on that day he called him Jerubbaal, saying, Let Baal plead against him, because he hath thrown down his altar.



## *A message from our Pastor*

*Praise the LORD, Saints!*

*“And the devils came out of many”* Luke 4:41 KJV.

There must be a problem in our world if devils possess the spirits of many. Perhaps we have become lackadaisical in our Christian community by leaving the gates unguarded. While we bask in the glory of God’s blessings, we have not been doing the complete job of being as wise as a serpent.

During the Edenic period, the devil possessed the makeup of a serpent to approach Adam and Eve. As they tended the idyllic Garden, their attention was distracted by the serpent’s attempt to twist God’s words. The devil could not enter the Garden because it was Holy Ground and a perfect place that knew no sin. The serpent could only speak to them from the outside since sin was not welcomed in that place.

The serpent could not get inside the Garden, so it got inside of their heads instead where it could cause indecision and invasion of spirit. Once the devil gets in your spirit, he can lead you to compromising your beliefs. The mind starts thinking incomprehensibly against God’s word in favor of what satisfies your flesh. It’s what the scriptures define as the lust of the eyes, the lust of the flesh and the pride of life.

The spirit is more powerful than the flesh. Knowing this, it’s understandable as how we sometimes can’t get out of our own way. We stumble, trip and fall because the flesh is weaker than the spirit. When Adam and Eve fell from grace, other devils were notified of how to weaken human nature. The evil one called the Devil, has sent many

demonic spirits into roaming the earth seeking whom they might devour.

Many are consumed by devils because they do not recognize the power of Jesus Christ our Lord. Until we recognize the power of our God, devils will reside in many. The devils know the power of God and are afraid of it. They heed to God and run from God because they know they cannot hide from him. You cannot hide the evil of sin, injustice and wickedness from God, but many people believe that they can.

God is everywhere He wants to be. God is everything we need Him to be. God is for whoever wants Him. He is available for everyone. It is God that should be in many and not devils.



# FEMA COVID-19

## Funeral Assistance

Under the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 and the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, FEMA will provide financial assistance for COVID-19-related funeral expenses incurred after January 20, 2020.

FEMA will begin to implement COVID-19 funeral assistance in April. In the meantime, people who have COVID-19 funeral expenses are encouraged to keep and gather documentation.

### Who is Eligible?

To be eligible for funeral assistance, you must meet these conditions:

- The death must have occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- The death certificate must indicate the death was attributed to COVID-19.
- The applicant must be a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien who incurred funeral expenses after January 20, 2020.
- There is no requirement for the deceased person to have been a U.S. citizen, non-citizen national, or qualified alien.

### How to Apply

Applications are being accepting applications. If you had COVID-19 funeral expenses, we encourage you to keep and gather documentation. Types of information should include:

- An official death certificate that attributes the death directly or indirectly to COVID-19 and shows that the death occurred in the United States, including the U.S. territories, and the District of Columbia.
- Funeral expenses documents (receipts, funeral home contract, etc.) that includes the applicant's name, the deceased person's name, the amount of funeral expenses, and the dates the funeral expenses happened.
- Proof of funds received from other sources specifically for use toward funeral costs. We are not able to duplicate benefits received from burial or funeral insurance, financial assistance received from voluntary agencies, government agencies, or other sources.

Lonnie Johnson  
Aerospace Engineer/Inventor/Entrepreneur  
(October 6, 1949 Age: 71)

Born in Mobile Alabama, he is one of six children. At an early age he would start building his own toys. He enjoyed solving problems, was considered highly intelligent and would build an air compressed robot out of scrap parts which would win him first place at the 1968 science fair.

After graduating from high school, he would attend Tuskegee University on scholarship and earn his bachelor’s degree in mechanical engineering. Two years later he would earn his master’s degree in nuclear engineering also from Tuskegee.

Johnson would join the U.S. Air Force and once his term of service was completed, he would work at NASA for 12 years. He would be a member of the team working on the stealth bomber program. Johnson has over 250 patents. When he was not working, he would work on his own inventions. While looking to develop an environmentally friendly heating pump using water instead of freon he created the super soaker water gun. It has been the best-selling toy since it was created in 1990. He is also the creator of the Nerf Gun.

Johnson Thermoelectric Energy Converter (JTEC) will convert solar energy into electricity with twice the efficiency of the current method being used, renewable solar energy. He will go down in history as one of the most successful inventors and entrepreneurs of his generation. He continues to work on perfecting his JTEC which once perfected will carve out a greater place in history as one of the seminal figures of the ongoing green technology revolution.
